



LOCAL RULES "TRE PIZZI" Trophy 2015"

The "Tre Pizzi" Trophy 2015 is an international event included in the FAI Events Calendar – cat. 2 - paragliding.

1. Organization	The "Tre Pizzi" Trophy 2015 is organized by Aero Club Lega Piloti in collaboration with Volo Libero Monte Gemmo.
2. Flying site	Flying area: Apennines of Umbria and Marche regions, Eastern sector, Fabriano-Camerino Valley included the northern area of Monti Sibillini. Headquarters: clubhouse V.L. Monte Gemmo at the official landing area in Esanatoglia (MC)
3. General Schedule	Registration: Wednesday, Sept 09, 2015, from 19.00 to 22.00 Contest flying days: from Thursday, Sept 10 to Sunday, Sept 13, 2015
	Prize-giving and closing ceremony: Sunday, Sept 13, 2015 at 19.00
4. Daily Schedule	The competition schedule might be changed because of weather condition and organization needs. Any schedule variation will be published on the official board at the Headquarters. Daily Schedule: 08:30 - Headquarter opens 09:00 - Pilots' briefing
	09:30 - Transport to take-off 11:30 - Meet Director / Task and Safety Committee meetings 12:00 - Pilots' briefing / Previous task official results / Task definition 12:30 - Take-off window opens 16:30 - Scoring office opens 22:00 - Provisional results
	Prize-giving and closing ceremony: Sunday, Sept 13, 2015 at 19.00
5. Regulations	Italian Sportive Regulations – Paragliding – Cross Country FAI Sporting Code Section 7B - Class O Paragliders (class 3)





6. Admitted paragliders	The admitted paragliders must be certified EN 926-2 and EN 926-1 B, C, D and CCC (Civl Competition Class). Paragliders certified EN A or similar will not be admitted.
	All CCC certified gliders must be flown in this configuration, even if previously purchased in the EN certified version. For these gliders, manufacturers have issued an upgrade Kit. The list of the certified CCC gliders is available on the FAI web site at the following link:

	All the gliders not included in the list, must be flown in the original configuration.
7. Validation and results	The competition will assign the title of Champion of "Tre Pizzi" Trophy 2015, with a minimum of a flown task.
	The following rankings will be produces:
	- Open Class: up to CCC certified gliders
	- Sport Class: up to EN C certified gliders - Female category (with at list 5 participants)
8. Complaint	Any complaint must be submitted before 9 a.m. of the day following the publication of the provisional results, or within 30 minutes from the publication
	of the final general results.
0 Porticipants	The maximum number of participants to the competition is 100
9. Participants	The maximum number of participants to the competition is 100.
	50% of participants will be selected referring to Italian General Ranking (on 31/10/2014).
	There will be available 10 wild cards.
40 D:	Remaining 40% will be selected using WPRS Ranking System (on 30/06/2015).

	In case of no valid tasks, the organisation will return to any participant part of the entry fee. The amount – from a minimum of 20 euros to a maximum of 60 euros – will be defined on the basis of the expenses afford by organizers.

	 National pilots License FAI Licence - class O Receipt of Entrance Fee payment Third-Party Insurance (Insurance number and Insurance Company)
	Note : All documents must be valid For safety purpose, to have a LPD and/or VHF radio, tuned on the frequencies set by the organizers is MANDATORY
14. GPS, Software and scoring system	Tracks will be downloaded using GPSDUMP For Scoring will be used FS Comp ver. 2015 (fs.fai.org) Used GPS must necessarily register the flight altitude, both GPS and barometric. The pilot has to provide a suitable cable to the organization. The MapDatum used is WGS84.
	Scoring System is PWC2014 with FTV 25 %.
	Parameters: MIN. DIST.: 5 Km NOM. DIST.: 40 Km NOM. TIME: 1,5 h NOM LAUNCH 96% NOM GOAL: 30%
