1. Organization	The event is organized by AEROCLUB LEGA PILOTI in collaboration with Parapendio Club "SCURBATT"
2. Flying site	Flying area: LARIAN TRIANGLE including the districts of Lecco, Como, Bergamo.
	Official Take-off: Monte Cornizzolo (LC) – alt 1.100mt slm
	Official Landing: landing area managed by "P.C. SCURBATT" and Paragliding Federal Technical Center – Suello (LC) – alt. 240 mt slm
	Headquarters: HQ AeC LEGA PILOTI at the official landing area in Suello (LC)
3. General Schedule	Registration and recognition flight day: Sunday, May 22, 2016
	Contest flying days: from Monday, May 23 to Saturday, May 28, 2016.
4. Daily Schedule	The competition schedule might change because of weather conditions and organization needs. Any schedule variation will be published in the official board at the HQ.

6. Admitted paragliders

The admitted paragliders must be certified EN 926-2 and EN 926-1 B, C, D and CCC (Civl Competition Class).

Paragliders certified EN A or similar will not be admitted.

All CCC certified gliders must be flown in this configuration, even if previously purchased in the EN certified version.

For these gliders, manufacturers have issued an upgrade Kit.

All the gliders not included in the list, must be flown in the original configuration.

7. Validation and Results The Competition will assign the title of "ITALIAN CHAMPION 2016", with a minimum of 1500 points.

> The Competition will assign the title of "CORNIZZOLO CUP 2016 OPEN", with a minimum of a flown task.

The following rankings will be produced:

- Open Class International
- Open Class Italian Championship
- Female Category International (with at list 5 participants)
- Female Category Italian Championship
- Sport Class International
- Sport Class Italian Championship

OPEN Class:

Includes all the partecipants (up to CCC certified gliders)

SPORT Class

Includes all the partecipants, except pilots using:

- CCC (CIVL Competition Class) certified gliders;
- Any certified glider with Flat Aspect Ratio over 7.0;
- Any of the following gliders in any size:
 - ✓ Dudek Coden
 - ✓ Gin Boomerang X
 - ✓ Niviuk Icepeak 6
 - ✓ Niviuk Icepeak 7
 - ✓ Ozone Enzo
 - ✓ Swing Core 2
 - ✓ Axis Mercury Sport
 - SkyCountry Evo-X

Any complaint must be submitted before 8.30 a.m. of the day following the publication of the provisional results, or within 30 minutes from the publication of the final general results.

9. Participants

The maximum number of participants to the competition is 125.

- 50% of participants will be selected using Italian General ranking.
- Remaining 50% using WPRS ranking system.

Nr. 3 wild cards to the Italian Team leader

10. Registration and Payment

Pilots must register on the official website https://airtribune.com/italianopen2016

Registration Dead line: Saturday, March 5, 2016.

Payment Dead Line: Tuesday, March 15, 2016

Selected pilots will receive the payment request and the updated list will be available on the official website https://airtribune.com/italianopen2016

Pilots will have to pay the entry fee within Tuesday, March 15, otherwise they will be replaced by the next in waiting list.

A fee of 30,00 euros will be applied to late registration and late payments.

11. Entry fee

Regular entry fee will be 170,00 euros, including:

- Transports to Take-off
- Retrievals each competition day
- Gadgets and Benefits offered by the Organizers
- Packed Lunch each competition day
- Medical emergency service
- Prize-giving Ceremony

In case of no valid tasks, the organisation will return to any participant part of the entry fee. The amount is established in 50,00.

Additional refunds will be defined on the basis of the expenses afforded by organizers.
