(note the Organisation reserve the right to require an observed pilot test flight prior to allowing entry to event).

- Be checked for valid Third Party / Search / Rescue / Med and Repatriation Insurance(s)
- Sign Pilot Indemnity and Waiver Document
- Sign Equipment Conformity Document.

To include: Pg Wing details / Safety rating, Reserve chute, Helmet, VHF Radio.

- Check-in and register personal GPS tracking devices
- Be confirmed into respective competition Class A, Class B(m) Class B(f)

Trackers

Official Organisation FlyMaster Trackers will be issued daily pre-task to each pilot. Pilots will return Trackers for download on checkin post task each day.

NOTE : The Organisation highly recommends that pilots fly with GPS based safety trackers (Garmin, Spot or similar) plus backup instruments capable of providing 3D IGC tracklog format flight log files.

Sites Available

Pir Chinasi, Muzaffarabad.

Pir Chanasi launch sits on an E-W ridge at 2850m ASL, 2100m above the valley floor and 7km distance from the main Lz at Muzaffarabad Airport runway. The Main Launch faces SW thru SE picking up morning thermals through to late evening. The site also offers West and North facing launch options. There are several buildings and shelters at launch. The extensive grassed setup area and launch is capable of having several gliders simultaneously ready for take-off. The road accessible drive from Lz to Launch is a 50 minute drive on good road direct to the summit launch. Two lower launches at 2800m and 2350m may be utilised if conditions dictate.

The local high mountain terrain and proven Xc routes can take pilots along spectacular ridges to peaks topping 4100m with views out to the High Karakoram a mere 100km away. Late September's dynamic and thermic flying conditions in the region are considered as moderate to strong which can provide unique tasking XC possibilities to the 4000m peaks in the region. Pilots can expect to top over 5,000m en route. Whilst achieving such heights is not necessary for accomplishing set Xc or Race tasks, pilots should be aware, capable and prepared for high altitude flying. Tasks will finish at the Muzaffarabad Runway Lz. For a taste of the area, take a look the inspired 65km flight by JeanLuc Wolf flown 22nd June.
