Entry and selection

Selection will start on February 8 and the final list will be published within February 10, 2020. Places will be assigned to pilots selected according to the FAI WPRS ranking system (reference date 1st February 2020).

Maximum number of pilots: **110**

- 40% of available spots are reserved to Italian pilots (until the first selection round). The selection will be made following the Italian Overall Ranking (reference date 31st October, 2019).
- - 20 spots are reserved to female pilots
- - 10 wild cards (to be assigned by the organizers and the Italian Team Leader)

In case of equal rankings, priority will be given to the first pilot who made the registration.

Registration to the competition becomes effective only after the entry fee payment, which has to be done within 7 days from the confirmation date.

Confirmation will be sent to pilots by email and published in the list of confirmed participants.

Pilots who won't pay within the payment deadline, will be moved at the bottom of the selection list and their status will be changed in "waiting list".

Organizers have the right to not accept the registration of pilots considered not eligible or in case the compliance with legal requirements cannot be verified.

Entry Fee

Regular entry fee is **145 €**

If registration is made after February 7, 2020 or if payment is made after the established deadline, the entry fee is 180 €.

The entry fee includes:

- ID card & safety/contact information
- Transport to take-off and retrievals
- Map with take-offs, turnpoints, landings, restricted areas
- Upload of turnpoints with GPS coordinates
- GPS track-log download
- Medical emergency service
- Live tracking
- Packed Lunch each competition day
- Gadgets
- Prize-giving ceremony

Refund Policy

In case of no valid tasks, the organisation will return to any participant part of the entry fee. The amount will be defined on the basis of the expenses afforded by organizers.

If a pilot withdraws from the competition by March 1, 2020, the entire registration fee will be refunded, minus 30%, to cover organizational costs. The refund will be made at the end of the competition.

Cancellations from March 2, 2020 and until the start of the competition won't be refunded.

Prize fund

The contest will be valid for the awarding of the title of "Flory Cup 2020" Champion (with at least one valid task).

Winners must be present at the awards ceremony to collect the prize. We do not accept proxies. Prizes not claimed will remain at the organization.

Contest categories

- Overall (B, C, D and CCC certified gliders)
- Serial (B, C, D certified gliders), if there are at least 10 participants
- Sport (B, C certified gliders), if there are at least 10 participants
- Female, if there are at least 5 participants
- The youngest and the oldest pilot of the comp

Documents needed at registration:

- National flight licence
- FAI Licence - class O
- Third Party Liability Insurance

NOTE: all documents must be valid

Insurance

Following insurance is needed in order to participate in this event. Appropriate documentary proof in English will be required at registration showing valid:

- Third Party Liability risk to the value of at least €100,000 (one hundred thousand)
- Individual Accident insurance covering paragliding specific activities outside the pilot's country of residence and during competitions
- Medical treatment coverage of at least 10,000 (ten thousand euro)
- Medical (helicopter) evacuation of at least 10,000 (ten thousand euro)
- Repatriation coverage

Medical Services

- Ambulance and first Aid staff on take-off and landing
- Helicopter evacuation (10 min. time)
- Hospital assistance - Ospedale San Bassiano (15 min. time)

Take-off

The take-off will be Rubbio, loc. Brombe, municipality of Conco.

Goal sites

The landing area is a wide field (500 mt length) in Valle San Floriano.

Airspace and other restrictions

Dedicated NOTAM will be issued.

Airspace Open Text file will be provided

Live tracking

Live tracking device and monitoring for safety issues will be provided by the organizers-

Dedicated person assigned to attend live tracking: Dora Arena

Scoring

Rankings will be processed using FS Comp (fs.fai.org), using the CIVL scoring formula GAP2018. The GPS must record both the barometric and GPS flight altitude.

For the scoring procedure, tracks will be downloaded from the Livetracking system. Other devices may be used as backup.

The organization will provide cables for Flymaster, Brauniger (Compeo, Compeo+), Compass, Garmin and Digifly.

If a different GPS is used, the pilot must provide a suitable cable.

The MapDatum will be WGS84 and the waypoints will be in UTM format.

Complaints

Any complaints must be written in English and submitted to the Meet Director before 9.00 a.m. on the day following publication of the provisional results or within 30 minutes from the publication of the final general results.

A deposit of € 50.00 is requested to present the complaint. If it is rejected, the deposit will not be returned.

Liability

The participation in this competition is at own risk of each pilot. The organizer takes no responsibility for pilots or any other third parties. Any transfer to take off and retrieval shuttle service are at own risk of pilots.

It is the responsibility of each competing pilot to ensure that he has valid insurance cover public liability risk, personal accident/hospitalisation/repatriation.
