COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS

Any pilot may issue a verbal complaint to the Meet Director to investigate operational matters with which the pilot is dissatisfied.

The Meet Director will investigate and make the final determination of the verbal complaint based on the merits of the issue.

Written protests will be reviewed to ensure they clearly state the reason, provide evidence supporting the protester's position and state the desired outcome.

The pilot must sign and date the protest. Protests not in this format will be rejected.

If the provisional results are published before 10 PM, complaints must be submitted before 10 AM the next day. If the provisional results are published after 10 PM, complaints must be submitted before noon the next day. For the last competition task, complaints must be submitted at the latest 1 hour after publication of the provisional results.

The Protest Committee will investigate and within 24 hours make their final determination based on the merits of the issue. Should the pilot still be dissatisfied; an appeal may be filed with the USHPA Competition Committee no later than 10 days after the competition. The protest fee will be refunded for all successful protests. As per General Section and Section 7A-7, the fee for protest will be \$20.
