Important Notes for Pilots

Paragliding Pilots will have spot checks on certification of equipment. Non certified equipment will lead to disqualification.

Classic parachute pilots will have spot checks on BHPA recommended practices.

Local Rules and other information can be found on the noticeboard.

ALL Pilot briefings are Mandatory.

Please note that some pilots will be flying in both the paragliding and parascending events.

Hang Gliders

The competition will be scored using GPS traces. Your instrument needs to be capable of this, or use your phone to record, and then emailed to the scorer. If using an instrument please bring any cable you need to retrieve the traces. Phone options include, on Android, Tracker (<https://mycloudbase.com/tracker/download.htm>) or on Apple (iOS), FlySkyHy, <https://apps.apple.com/us/app/flyskyhy/id516879039>. Please test out your tracking prior to the competition. Any queries please email richard.hunt@mycloudbase.co.uk.

A Telegram group will be set up to coordinate retrievals amongst ourselves, at present there is no centralised retrieve point but we will ensure there is at least one person available to commence retrievals. On landing please immediately share your location, and then once you have made your way to a pick-up point.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

In an emergency the following procedure shall be followed:

- The Meet Director is to take charge. If he / she is not available then the nominated deputy shall take charge.
- All towing shall be suspended.
- Any airborne pilots should land as soon as they are aware of the accident.
- The casualty is to be assessed by the nearest First Aider.
- The First Aider decides if the emergency services should be called and communicates this to the Meet Director.
- The Meet Director calls the guard room (01285 868247) by phone to request the emergency services. Use the phrase "casualty fallen from height in remote location" if an aviation incident. No other person should contact the emergency services as this could cause confusion.
- Access to site for the emergency services will be via the east crash gate. The Meet Director shall appoint someone to open the crash gate and guide the ambulance.
- Where necessary first aid is to be carried out on the casualty until the Ambulance crew arrive and take over.

All incidents must be reported to the Event Safety Officer, an Accident Report Form filled in and submitted to the BHPA.

If the incident is fatal or potentially fatal or any other serious incidents the BHPA must be informed immediately on 0116 289 4316.
