- 2. British Open (Class 1, Class 5 and Class 1 Sports)

SELECTION AND REQUIREMENTS

Maximum number of pilots: 100

Eligibility to compete in the UK National Championships is BHPA Advanced Pilot Rating. Eligibility to compete in the British Open is minimum BHPA Pilot rating (for UK pilots), or National Rating Card and IPPI Card Stage 5 (Senior Pilot) (for non-UK pilots).

Documents required at registration

FAI Sporting Licence

- IPPI Card (non-UK pilots)
- Pilot's National licence
- Signed registration form
- Signed Release of liability, Waiver of Legal rights
- Passport or driver's license
- Insurance

Insurance

The organisers require documentary proof <u>in English</u> of valid Insurance covering public liability risk to the value of minimum 750 000 Euro (or monetary equivalent) be presented to the organisers at registration. All participants must have a valid medical health care insurance (covering all hospital expenses, rescue and repatriation). It is each pilot's responsibility to ensure that his/her medical insurance cover him/her specifically for Hang Gliding competition events.

For Ager, Spanish nationals are excluded from the requirement for medical evacuation and repatriation insurance.

ENTRY FEE AND SERVICES PROVIDED

Entry Fee

Amount In local currency: £150 (GBP). Amount in Euro equivalent: According to prevailing tourist exchange rate. After 27th July 2023 the entry fee will rise to £190.

Payment deadline: 27th July 2023 (£150 discount rate). On registration (£190 full rate).

Payment Details: PayPal via Airtribune.

Refund policy: If a pilot withdraws from the competition before July 27th 2023 the entire registration fee will be refunded.

There will be no refund for pilots who cancel from July 27th 2023 onwards.

If the competition is cancelled due to the Covid-19 situation, the entire registration fee will be refunded.

COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS

Protest committee composition: The protest committee will consist of three competitors to be chosen before the first task.

Application to compete

Registration

Registration according to FAI Sporting Code Common Section 7-5 and Section 7A-2. Entry forms will be completed, checked and signed.

Equipment

All equipment must comply with Section 7A-4 and 8, and CIVL GAP. in addition pilots are required to fly with: mobile telephone and 2m radio.

Task Advisory Committee

According to Common Section 7-4.3.1 will include the Meet Director plus 3 pilots from the Nationals Main Class and may include a local or suitably experienced international pilot.

Safety Committee

A safety committee lead will be selected by the MD. It will include 5 pilots formed by the head of the safety committee comprising of a minimum 3 pilots from the main class and up to 2 pilots from the sports class (see Common Section 7-4.4.2).

Take-off sites

Main take offs will be Serra del Montsec. If weather conditions dictate, alternate take offs may be considered.

Flying days

A flying day is defined as a day when the launch window has been opened

Launch

In accordance with Section 7A-3 the launch system is open window. The launch lane system will be briefed daily, site dependant.

Relaunch.

A competitor will be allowed a maximum of 2 take offs providing start gate has not been taken. The flight must be logged and stored for verification purposes. The re-light must be reported to the MD prior to the second launch.

Launch window

For the task to be valid, the launch window must be open for at least 45minutes.

Airspace and other restrictions

There are no specific airspace limitations except those on the issued waypoints/airspace files. Any changes to these occurring during a task will be briefed to the pilots. NOTAMs will be issued for the site during the competition to ensure maximum safety precautions are met. Airspace files will be provided in Openair format.

Goal

There are no goal specific rules. Competition area has sufficient safe landing points.

Pre-Flyers and Free flyers

According to Common Section 7-7.

Safety Issues

According to Section 7A 8.7 Pilots are to report to the MD in the first instance.

Scoring

According to Section 7A-5.

Scoring will use the FS scoring program, using CIVL GAP scoring formula GAP2022 The GPS map datum is WGS 84 and the coordinate format to be used is Minutes (d°m.m')
