Eligibility	<p>Pilots must have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a valid flight license to fly legally in the host country, in compliance with• local and international laws. The license for cross-country flights (IPPI• level 5) is mandatory.• Third party liability insurance valid in Italy• Valid FAI sporting license
Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certified and airworthy paraglider (EN 926/2, EN926/1) flown within the certified weight range and configuration. A change of equipment during the competition is only allowed with the permission of the Meet Director. For the safety of the pilots and to achieve equal opportunities, the competition officials may carry out a weight and configuration checks at any time. If a pilot flies his/her glider outside the certification weight limits, he/she will be scored zero for that day. To fly a glider out of its certified configuration may lead to the expulsion from the competition.• Mandatory equipment: certified helmet, adequate rescue system and certified harness• 2m band radio device
Entry fee	<p>The entry fee is 220.00 €. Confirmation Refund	<p>Confirmed pilots must pay within 7 days from receiving the selection notice. Otherwise they will be moved at the end of the queue.</p> <p>The event will only take place with a minimum of 70 paying pilots on 20th June, 2026. In case of cancellation a minimum of 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.</p> <p>The Trophy will be valid even with only one task. If not even one valid task is disputed, the organisation will consider the refund amount based on the already spent costs.</p> <p>Pilots who withdraw from the participation will receive a refund as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cancellation before June 20th 2026: 70% refund to cover organizational costs. The refund will be made at the end of the competition. ● Cancellation from 21st June 2026 and until the start of the competition won't be refunded.
Prizegiving	<p>The Alpen Cup 2026 - 41st Guarnieri International Trophy money prize will be shared out among the first 3 pilots of the open results</p> <p>1st - 50% of total prize 2nd - 30% of total prize 3rd - 20% of total prize</p> <p>To receive the prize, pilots must be present at the prize-giving ceremony; otherwise the prizes will remain to Para&Delta Club Feltre.
